

## INTEGRATED BASIN

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**PROFESSIONAL INSTALLATION REQUIRED - CONTRACTOR AND PLUMBER needed for Installation.**

- Please read all instructions carefully before assembling.
- For your safety, assembly by two or more adults is strongly recommended.
- Keep instructions for future use.
- This AI is for Basin only, for the assemble of the Base, please refer to the AI for Base.
- **DO NOT USE PLUMBERS PUTTY OR ANY OIL BASED SEALANT AS THIS WILL STAIN THE BASIN.**

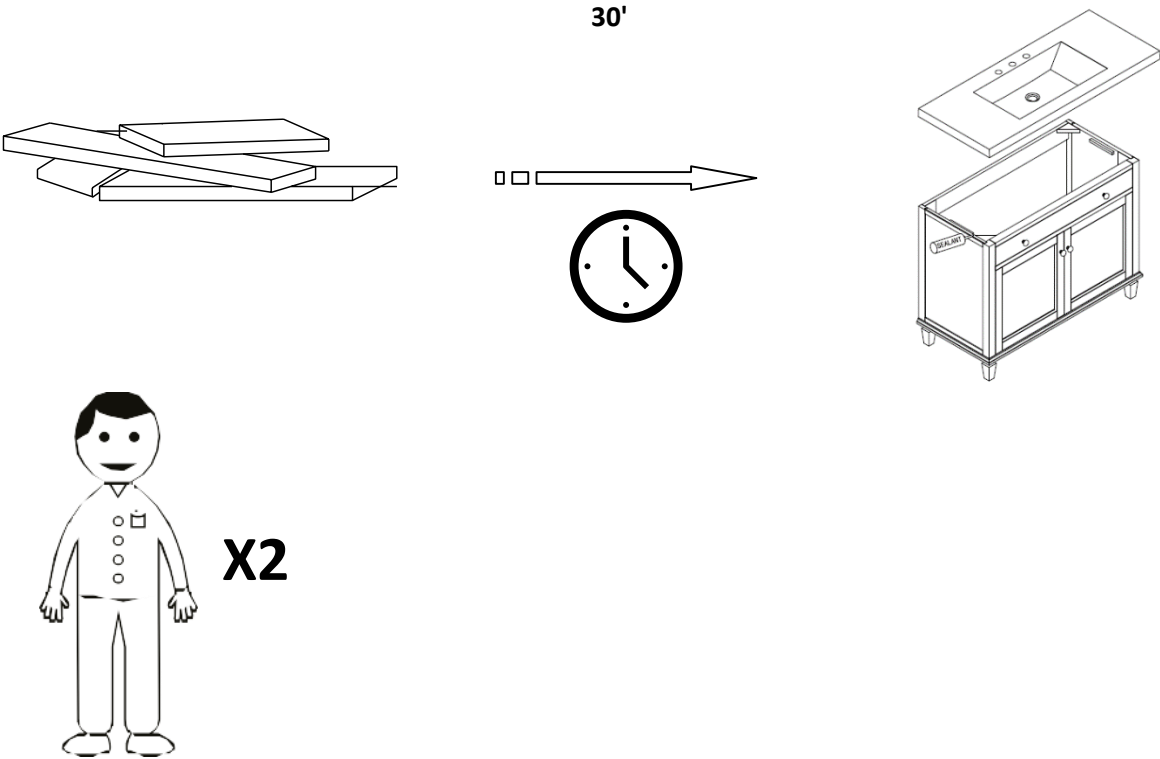
**PRE-ASSEMBLY:**

- Remove all parts and hardware from the box and lay out on a clear carpeted or scratch-free work surface, as this will avoid damaging parts during assembly. The shipping box provides an ideal work surface.
- Do not dispose of any packaging or contents of the shipping carton until assembly is completed to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Use the parts and hardware lists below to identify and separate each of the pieces included.
- The illustrations provided allow for easier assembly when used in conjunction with the assembly instructions.
- The use of power tools to aid in assembly is not recommended. Power tools can damage hardware and split wood.
- Keep all parts out of the reach of children.
- A standard 8" spread faucet should be used with this Basin top.




## 1. Attach the basin top to the vanity base

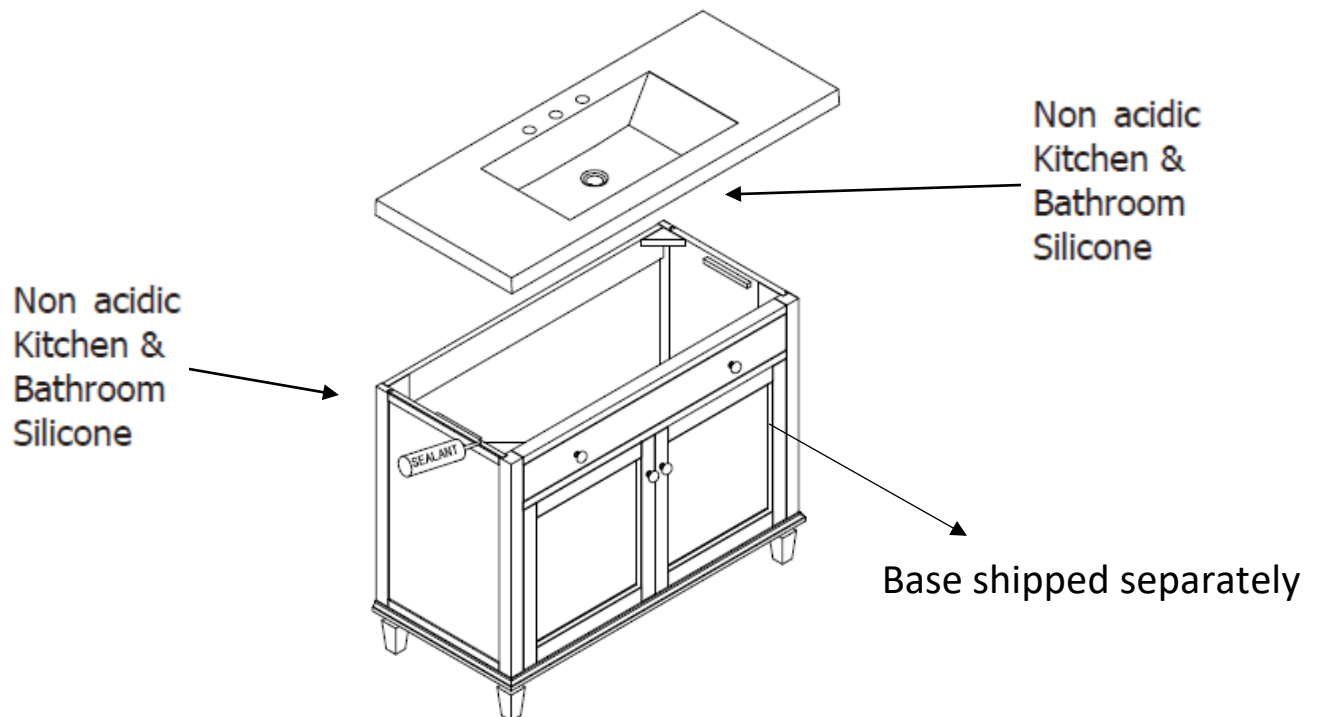
**Note: Sealant must be non acidic silicon.**

**Plumbers Putty must not be used as it will stain the Top.**

**Please ensure the base has been assembled before putting the basin on.**

1a. Apply Sealant

1b. Lower and Center the basin Top Assembly to Vanity Case.



1c. Wipe off excess Sealant.

1d. Let Sealant cure according to manufacturer's directions before installing plumbing fixtures.

**2. The unit must be sealed along the back edge of the top and down the sides against the wall with non acidic bathroom & kitchen silicone. Seal around the cabinet with silicone.**

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## Care Instructions

### Basin Care:

Gently clean with liquid soap and dry. Using warm water, liquid soap, and a sponge, gently clean the basin. Avoid scrubbing, and remove discoloration using bleach on white porcelain. Tackle deeper stains with a mild abrasive.

### Base Care:

To protect the finish, avoid the use of all chemical and household cleaners with abrasives as they may damage the finish.

Avoid all types of abrasive cleaners and rough cleaning pads. Do not use any products that contain acids, as this can cause the finish to dull.

Liquid spills should be cleaned promptly.

Placing protective pads on the bottom of any heavy objects will help prevent scratching of the basin surface.

Do not place extremely heavy items on the top.
